About Asian Dispute Review

Asian Dispute Review (*Asian DR*) is a quarterly journal, sponsored by the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre, the Hong Kong Mediation Council, the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (East Asia Branch) and the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators.

With a circulation of 7,500 copies, *Asian DR*'s readership comprises lawyers, legal consultants, arbitrators, mediators, ADR neutrals, academics and people from all trades and other professions who are interested in private dispute resolution. The journal's geographical distribution ranges from Hong Kong to other areas of Asia and throughout the world.

Submission Guidelines

Each edition of the journal generally comprises approximately 6 papers, a news section and a book review. We welcome the submission of papers for consideration from any of our readers. The Submission Guidelines are as follows:

Papers should

- focus on arbitration, mediation and other forms of ADR and be written in a style that is easily understood by lay readers
- not discuss substantive law, though brief comment on substantive law may be included to the extent that it adds to the understanding of the arbitration/ADR content
- not have been published in or submitted to another journal or newsletter, or be available online
- not be on a subject covered in depth by any paper in the previous three issues of Asian DR
- be approximately 2,500 words
- contain no more than 30 footnotes, the content of which should primarily be concerned with referencing and citation.
- give proper citations from the law reports for all reported cases. Where cases have been reported, they should not be cited as 'unreported' or give neutral court citations.

All papers should be submitted in Microsoft Word format. Please adopt straightforward and simple formatting instructions into submitted copy.

In order to schedule topics for each issue of the journal and achieve a good balance of content, we would be grateful if, prior to submitting articles, authors would submit a working title and brief summary of the paper's content.

All papers are approved for publication by the *Asian DR* Editorial Board, who reserve the right to edit all material and to refuse to publish any inappropriate content.
